Re: Works update

As you are aware Irish Water is carrying out a major watermain replacement in Swords. GMC Utilities Group is working on behalf of Irish Water to deliver this project.

Included below are details of traffic management and some information you may find useful.

Traffic Management

GMC Utilities Group intends to close a section of **Forest Road** to facilitate the works. The road closure period granted by Fingal County Council extends from **08:00am on Monday 28 May 2018 to 5:00pm on Sunday 24 June 2018**. Traffic will be diverted as indicated in the drawings overleaf.

Pedestrian access will be maintained for students of Colaiste Choilm using the back gate on Forest Road.

Noise:

We will monitor noise levels in the vicinity of the works and are cognizant of students sitting exams. The works close to Colaiste Choilm will be undertaken using trenchless technology and we do not anticipate any significant noise disruption. Acoustic barriers will be erected if the noise exceeds acceptable levels.

Working Hours:

Works are progressing well and there will not be a requirement for additional works to be carried out during the night.
