Book Rental Scheme (BRS) 2020 – 2021

* symbol indicates items **not** included in **Book Rental Scheme 20/21 (BRS)** e.g. test papers, copybooks, novels, other prescribed material for specific years, log tables, dictionaries, workbooks are **not included**. **Textbook/Workbook Packs are included**, however, **if workbook is sold separately it is not included** in scheme.

Note for 1st/2nd year students – Books for 1st & 2nd Year (availed of through BRS) which are required for the entire 3 year programme, must be retained until student completes 3rd year at which point all books for 3 year Junior Cycle programme must be returned. Any books which are not being used in 2nd or 3rd Year must be returned on completion of 1st Year.

Under the BRS **2020/2021** – books must be returned in the good condition in which they were distributed. Any books deemed not re-usable by the school will be the liability of the student/parent. Failure to comply may result in withdrawal from BRS for the following year.

In the event of over subscription to the Scheme the final decision of participation rests with the School Principal.
