Book Rental Scheme (BRS) 2022 - 2023

* symbol indicates items <u>not</u> included in **Book Rental Scheme 22/23 (BRS)** e.g. test papers, copybooks, novels, other prescribed material for specific years, log tables, dictionaries, workbooks are <u>not included</u>. **Textbook/Workbook <u>Packs are included</u>**, however, <u>if workbook is sold separately it is not included</u> in scheme.

<u>Note for 1st/2nd year students</u> – Books for 1st & 2nd Year (availed of through BRS) which are required for the entire 3 year programme, must be retained until student completes 3^{rd} year at which point all books for 3 year Junior Cycle programme must be returned. Any books which are not being used in 2nd or 3rd Year must be returned on completion of 1st Year.

Under the BRS **2022/2023** – books must be returned in the good condition in which they were distributed. Any books deemed not re-usable by the school will be the liability of the student/parent. Failure to comply may result in withdrawal from BRS for the following year.
