#### Book Rental Scheme (BRS) 2023 – 2026

\* symbol indicates items <u>not</u> included in **Book Rental Scheme 23/26 (BRS)** e.g. test papers, copybooks, novels, other prescribed material for specific years, log tables, dictionaries, workbooks are <u>not included</u>. **Textbook/Workbook <u>Packs are included</u>**, however, <u>if workbook is sold separately it is not included</u> in scheme.

**Note for 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> year students** – Books for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Year (availed of through BRS) which are required for the entire 3 year programme, must be retained until student completes  $3^{rd}$  year at which point all books for 3 year Junior Cycle programme must be returned. Any books which are not being used in 2<sup>nd</sup> or  $3^{rd}$  Year must be returned on completion of  $1^{st}$  Year.

Under the BRS **2023/2026** – books must be returned in the good condition in which they were distributed. Any books deemed not re-usable by the school will be the liability of the student/parent. Failure to comply may result in withdrawal from BRS for the following year.
